Regulation "R. Caccioppoli" Prize

Art.1

Mathematics Italian Union shall award in perpetuity a four-year prize in memoriam of professor Renato Caccioppoli. The prize is awarded to mathematics sciences academics.

Art. 2

The prize fund currently consists of the donation by prof. Giovambattista Ceppalunni and of the contribute of University of Naples "Federico II" as well as interest accrued and interest to be accrued. In addition to the contribution of the promoters, the award fund budget can be increased through further sponsorships from individuals or institutions.

Art. 3

The prize shall be awarded through competition based on qualifications. The call will be announced every four year within the 31st December starting from 31st December 1998.

Art. 4

The call announcement shall be advertised on 'Bollettino' of Mathematics Italian Union. The expiry day for the submission of the applications will be at least 60 days after the date of the call announcement.

Art. 5

The amount of the prize will be established on each time by UMI Presidency Office, taking into account the interest accrued from the investment of the fund.

Art. 6

Those eligible to the award are mathematics sciences academics of Italian nationality whose 39th birthday does not occur by 31th December of the year preceding that one in which the prize is awarded.

Art. 7

The application forms must be sent to the UMI President exclusively by electronic means. To the applications shall be attached in PDF format a copy of an identity document attesting nationality and date of birth of the candidate, his/her curriculum vitae, a list of his/her publications and an electronic copy of the publications.

Art. 8

Only printed publications shall be admitted.

Art. 9

The Prizes are indivisible and they are awarded by a panel consisting in 5 members appointed by UMI Presidency Office.

Art. 10

The Commission shall award the prize considering the whole scientific production of the applicant. The prize could be awarded also to a person who did not submit application form, nominated by UMI members, Universities, Research institutes and Scientific. The nominated candidates must be under the conditions described in Article 6 of this regulation.

Art. 11

Commission resolutions may be adopted with simple majority vote. As regard to the scientific content, Commission resolutions are unquestionable.

Art. 12

If the Commission did not act to award the prize, it shall be awarded the following year.

Art. 13

The Commission must draw up a detailed report of its works. It will be published on UMI 'Bollettino'.

Art. 14

This regulation may be amended with the procedures under articles 4 and 5 of 'Offerta di Donazione' by professor Ceppaluni.
