

Federigo Enriques Prize

The following agreement is concluded between

the Mathematics Italian Union (UMI)
Piazza di Porta San Donato 5, 40126 Bologna

and

the Enriques Study Center (CSE)
via Roma 234, 57127 Livorno

Art. 1 Starting from 2014 UMI collaborates with CSE in organizing the “Federigo Enriques” Prize, established by CSE in 2003 and already realized in three editions.

Art. 2 The prize of 2.000 euro is indivisible and it will be announced every two years starting from 2014. The call, written in Italian, English and French, is published both on the UMI and the CSE website.

Art. 3 The Prize is awarded to a doctoral thesis which contains original and very relevant research results on subjects connected to Federigo Enriques’ mathematical thought.

Art. 4 Those eligible to apply are doctoral researcher who have obtained the title with a doctoral thesis on mathematical topics during the two years prior the day of the dispatch of the call.

Art. 5 Applications shall be submitted within the deadline of the call to UMI headquarter by exclusively electronic means. Application shall contain a PDF format copy of the thesis and its summary of maximum 10 pages, which highlight the most original aspects. Texts may be presented in any Community language. If the language of the texts will be different from Italian, Castilian, English or French, a translation of the original documents in one of these languages must be attached to the application. Electronic format copies of both thesis and summary shall be sent no longer the deadline to the UMI email.

Art. 6 The prize will be awarded through the unquestionable judgment of the committee, consisting in 5 members. One of them will be the UMI President, who will preside over the committee itself, while the other 4 members will be mathematicians appointed by the UMI Scientific Commission, taking into account the proposals from CSE. The Committee may work electronically and it must draw up a final report of its works containing the reasons of the prize’s awarding. Committee reserves the right to abstain from awarding the prize, if none of work presented is considered to have reached the required standard.

Art. 7 The prize will be awarded during the UMI General Meeting or during the annual UMI Members Meeting.

Art. 8 The costs related to the prize are distributed between CSE and UMI. CSE shall undertake to pay 1.000 euro upon notification by UMI the end of the works of the Committee under article 5.

Art. 9 This agreement shall remain in force for a period of four years after signature by the parties and it will be tacitly renewed for additional periods of four years, unless one of the parties terminates it on twelve months’ notice from the deadline.
