



Agreement of cooperation between the Unione Matematica Italiana and the King's College London

The Unione Matematica Italiana (UMI) and King's College London (King's) hereby jointly establish a procedure granting Visiting Student status at King's to Italian PhD students with an excellent scientific profile.

- 1) UMI will select among the graduate students that have obtained their degree in an Italian univerity, students of the highest scientific profile who could visit King's for one term.
- 2) With the help of the mathematics department at King's, each selected student will identify a supervisor within the members of the mathematics department at King's.
- 3) Each visiting student will receive a King's ID Card, to be used for libraries, computer rooms, lounge and possibly other facilities.
- 4) Each visiting student will be able to attend modules at King's. The instructors of these modules may be asked to provide a declaration of the regular attendance and the proficiency of the student.
- 5) UMI will select at most two visiting students per year. The selection will be conducted at least six months before the beginning of the term, noting that King's terms start in September and January.
- 6) The deadline and the instructions for applications will be posted on the UMI website http://umi.dm.unibo.it.
