



Agreement of cooperation concerning the mobility on the doctoral level

between

the Unione Matematica Italiana

(Italy)

and

École Polytechnique

(France)

The Unione Matematica Italiana (UMI), herein referred to as "UMI", with legal domicile in Piazza Porta San Donato 5, I-40126 Bologna (Italie), represented by its President, **Ciro Ciliberto**

and

École Polytechnique with legal domicile in Route de Saclay, 91128 Palaiseau (France), represented by its Vice President for Academic Affairs and Research **Frank Pacard** on behalf of its President **Jacques Biot**

hereby jointly establish a procedure granting Visiting Student status at l'École Polytechnique to Italian PhD students in mathematics with an excellent scientific profile.

- 1) UMI will select among the graduate students that have obtained their degree in an Italian university, students of the highest scientific profile who could visit École Polytechnique for one term.

With the help of the PhD Program and the concerned department of École Polytechnique, each selected student will identify a supervisor within the members of the mathematics or applied mathematics department at École Polytechnique.

- 2) Each visiting student, with the support of the hosting laboratory, will receive an ID Card of École Polytechnique, to be used for libraries, computer rooms, lounge and possibly other facilities.
- 3) Each visiting student will be able to attend modules at École Polytechnique. The instructors of these modules may be asked to provide a declaration of the regular attendance and the proficiency of the student.
- 4) UMI will select at most two visiting students per year.
- 5) The deadline and the instructions for applications will be posted on the UMI website <http://umi.dm.unibo.it>.
