

UMI-SISM PRIZE 2016

Art. 1 The Mathematics Italian Union (UMI) and the Italian Society of History of Mathematics (SISM) announce a prize for a work or a group of works of great scientific value in History of Mathematics field, with special reference to developments of mathematics in Italy.

Art.2 Those entitled to apply are young students under 40 years old. within the deadline set by the call. Motivated submissions may be proposed by academic bodies, research institutes, scientific academies or individual consultants.

Art. 3 Applications to competition and submissions under the terms at article 2 shall be submitted to the UMI administrative office (dipmat.umi@unibo.it) no later than 31 December 2016. Applications shall contain the following information:

- Applicant Name, Surname and email address
- Applicant curriculum vitae in PDF format, aimed of framing his/her work in relation to the publications subject of evaluation.
- List of publications subject of evaluations in PDF format (single work or group of works)
- Copy of the publications (single work or group of works) in PDF format
- Summary of the publications (single work or group of works) in PDF format (maximum 10 pages)

Art. 5 The prize consists in an indivisible amount of 3.000 euro, to which UMI and SISM are contributing in equal parts. The prize will be awarded with unquestionable resolutions by a panel consisting in 5 members: 3 of them will be appointed by UMI Scientific Commission on a proposal from the UMI Presidency, the other 2 will be appointed by SISM Board of Directors on a proposal from the SISM Presidency. The Commission resolution may be taken by simple majority and with regard to the substance are unquestionable. The Commission may work electronically. In case of absent applicants or scientifically valuable submissions the Commission has the right not to award the prize. The Commission must draw up a report its works, containing the reasons of the prize's awarding and a potential fully argued mention of maximum two other most eligible candidates.

Art. 6 The assignment of the price is decided by an agreement between the UMI Scientific Commission and the SISM Board of Directors and it will take place during the UMI Shareholders Meeting in May 2017.

Art. 7 The participation in the prize competition implies acceptance of the present regulations.
