



Agreement of cooperation between the Unione Matematica Italiana and the department of Mathematics at KTH Royal Institute of Technology

The Unione Matematica Italiana (UMI) and the **the department of Mathematics at the** Royal Institute of Technology (KTH) hereby jointly establish a procedure granting Visiting Student status at KTH to Italian PhD students with an excellent scientific profile.

- 1) UMI will select among the graduate students that have obtained their degree in an Italian University, students of the highest scientific profile who could visit KTH for one term.
- 2) With the approval and help of the mathematics department at KTH, each selected student will be granted a status of temporary visiting graduate student¹ and will identify a supervisor within the mathematics department at KTH.
- 3) Each visiting student will receive a KTH ID Card, to be used for libraries, computer rooms, lounge and possibly other facilities.
- 4) UMI will select at most two visiting students per year. The selection will be conducted at least five months before the beginning of the term, noting that KTH's terms start by at the end of August and in mid January.
- 5) The deadline and the instructions for applications will be posted on the UMI website <http://umi.dm.unibo.it>.
