

Regulations for Franco Tricerri Prize

Art. 1

Following the mandate of the Committee in memory of Franco Tricerri, the TRICERRI PRIZE, destined to a young Ph.D. graduate, is set up. The Prize is in memory of the distinguished mathematician of the Department "Ulisse Dini" in Florence and of his family, tragically died in 1994. The Prize will be funded by the biannual income of a fund paid in to this purpose by the Committee to the Italian Mathematical Union.

Art. 2

The Prize is awarded in a single tranche and it is compatible with other scholarships, research grants and scientific prizes. The amount of the Prize shall be determined by UMI's Executive Committee before the announcement of the relevant call.

The prize shall be awarded through a selection process based on qualifications. The call will be announced every two years.

Art. 3

The call will be published on UMI's website and on the 'Notiziario dell'Unione Matematica Italiana' by 31 August of the year before the award of the Prize. The deadline for the submission of applications will be the 28th February of the year in which the Prize is awarded.

Art. 4

To be eligible for the Prize, candidates must have earned their Ph.D. degree at an European University with a thesis in the field of Differential Geometry not later than

three years before the deadline for submissions.

Art. 5

Candidates must submit their applications to the UMI President exclusively in electronic form, attaching a copy of a valid identity document and a copy of the Ph.D. thesis in PDF format.

Art. 6

The Prize is indivisible and is awarded by a Commission of 3 members appointed by UMI's Executive Committee.

Art. 7

The Commission may decide not to award the Prize. In that case the amount of the non-awarded Prize shall increase the capital.

Art. 8

The Commission must draw up a detailed report of its works, that will be published on UMI's web site and on the 'Notiziario dell'Unione Matematica Italiana'.
