

# FEDERIGO ENRIQUES PRIZE

## Regulations

The following Agreement is stipulated between  
Unione Matematica Italiana (UMI)  
Piazza di Porta San donato 5, 40126 Bologna

and

Centro Studi Enriques (CSE)  
via Roma 234, 57127 Livorno

### Art.1

Starting from 2014, the UMI cooperates with the CSE to organize the “Federigo Enriques” Prize, established in 2003 by the CSE and already awarded for three editions.

### Art.2

The Prize is awarded in a single tranche of 2,000 euro, as well as UMI membership dues for three years. The Prize is announced every two years, starting from 2014. The call of the Prize is published on the UMI and the CSE websites in Italian, English and French.

### Art.3

The Prize is awarded for a doctoral thesis, which contains original and very relevant research results on topics related to Federigo Enriques’ mathematical work.

### Art.4

To be eligible for the Prize, candidates must have earned their Ph.D. degree in a European university with a thesis on mathematical topics no later than two years before the deadline for submission. For the candidates who took parental leave, this period is incremented of one year for each child born after the Ph.D. degree.

### Art.5

Applications must be submitted to the secretary only by e-mail within the submission deadline. Applications must contain a PDF format copy of the thesis and its summary of maximum 10 pages, which highlights the most original aspects of it. Texts may be presented in any EU language. If the language of the texts will be different from Italian, Castilian, English or French, a translation of the original documents in one of these languages above must be attached to the application.

### Art.6

The Prize will be awarded upon the unquestionable judgment of the committee, which will be composed of 5 members. One of them will be the UMI President, who will preside over the committee itself, while the other 4 members will be mathematicians appointed by the UMI Scientific Commission, taking into account proposals from the CSE. The Committee reserves the right to not award the prize, if none of the applications meets the required standards.

Art.7

The prize will be awarded during the UMI Congress or during the UMI Members Meeting.

Art.8

The Prize is funded by a fund paid by CSE and UMI. CSE undertakes to set the sum of 1,000 euro to UMI upon the notification of the end of the Committee's work under art. 5.

Art.9

This Agreement remains in force for four years after signatures by the two parties. It will be tacitly extended for further periods of four years, except in case of cancellation by one of the two parties within a 12-month notice before the expiration date.
