



RENATO CACCIOPPOLI PRIZE 2018

The Italian Mathematical Union announces the Renato Caccioppoli Prize 2018, which is awarded to Italian mathematicians who are not older than 38 by December 31st, 2018. This age will be increased by one year both for each child (or parental leave) or for a leave, due to health reasons, longer than 6 months.

The Prize is awarded in a tranche of 5,000 euro and it also includes three years of UMI membership dues. The prize is awarded upon unquestionable resolutions of the Committee, which is appointed by the UMI Executive Office. The prize will be awarded during the XXI UMI Congress, which will take place in Pavia, 2-7 September 2019.

The Committee will award the prize considering the whole scientific production of the applicant. The prize might be awarded also to a person who does not submit any application form, but he/she must be under the conditions mentioned above.

Those who want to apply must send the application form to the UMI President exclusively in electronic form by **February 28th, 2019**. A copy of an identity document attesting nationality and date of birth of the candidate, his/her curriculum vitae, a list of his/her publications and an electronic copy of the publications must be attached to the application in PDF format. Only published papers will be admitted.
