



## Calogero Vinti Prize 2018 - Call

The Italian Mathematical Union announces the "Calogero Vinti" Prize 2018.

This Prize is awarded in a lump sum of 4.000 euros; it also includes three years of UMI dues. The prize will be awarded during the XXI UMI Congress, which will take place in Pavia from the September 2<sup>nd</sup> to September 7<sup>th</sup>, 2019.

The prize is indivisible and it will be awarded on unquestionable resolutions of the Committee appointed by UMI's Executive Committee (art. 4 of the Regulations).

Eligible candidates are researchers in Mathematical Analysis whose 41th birthday does not occur by 31 December 2018. This age will be increased by one year both for each child (or parental leave) or for a leave, due to health reasons, longer than 6 months. (art. 3 of the Regulations).

The application form must be sent only by e-mail to the UMI President within 31 March 2019, attaching a copy of a valid identity document certifying citizenship and date of birth, a curriculum vitae and a list of publications in .pdf format.

The prize might be awarded also to a person who has not submitted the application form (art. 5 of the Regulations).
