



## Regulation “Calogero Vinti” Prize

### Art. 1

The Vinti Family will pay every four years an amount of [8.000.000 Lire] 4.000 euro to UMI over period of twenty years starting from the award of the first prize. The first payment will be made within the 31st August 1999, the second one within the 31st August 2003 and so on, until the 31st August 2019.

### Art. 2

With the abovementioned amounts UMI will award four-year prizes of [8.000.000 Lire] 4.000 euro each. The prizes are dedicated to Calogero Vinti. Each prize shall be awarded through competition which will be announced for the first time within the 31st of December 1998, for the second time within the 31st of December 2002 and so on, until 31st December 2018.

### Art. 3

Those eligible to the award are mathematics analysis academics of Italian nationality whose 41th birthday does not occur by 31th December of the expiring year of the call announcement. This age will be increased by one year both for each child (or parental leave) or for a leave, due to health reasons, longer than 6 months.

### Art. 4

Each Prize is indivisible. The Prize will be awarded by a Commission appointed by UMI Executive Committee. The Commission will evaluate with unquestionable resolutions the entire scientific production of the candidate.

### Art. 5

The application forms must be sent to the UMI President for the first time within the 31th March 1999, for the second time within the 31th March 2003 and so on, until the 31th March 2018. The application forms must be sent by exclusively electronic means. To the applications shall be attached in PDF format a copy of an identity document attesting nationality and date of birth of the candidate, his/her curriculum vitae and a list of his/her publications. UMI members, Universities, Research institutes and Scientific academies may submit nominations, within the call deadline, attaching the curriculum vitae and the list of publications of the candidates. In case of absent applicants or scientifically valuable submissions the Commission has the right not to award the prize.

### Art. 6

The Prize will be awarded every four years during the opening ceremony of the UMI Meeting starting from 1999 to 2019. The winner undertakes to hold a conference at University of Perugia.

### Art. 7

The methods for awarding the prize may be amended in any time by UMI's Executive Committee on a proposal of the UMI's Scientific Commission with the prior consent of the Vinti family.
