

REGULATION OF THE GOLD MEDAL “GUIDO STAMPACCHIA” PRIZE

The “International School of Mathematics “Guido Stampacchia”, part of the “Ettore Majorana Foundation and Centre for Scientific Culture”, and the Mathematics Italian Union (Unione Matematica Italiana) announce the international Gold Medal “Guido Stampacchia” Prize.

The prize, consisting in a gold medal, will be awarded for significant research in the field of Variational Analysis and Applications to a researcher who must not have reached the age of 35 by the end of the year of the call announce.

The “International School of Mathematics “Guido Stampacchia”, part of the “Ettore Majorana Foundation and Centre for Scientific Culture”, shall provide at its own expense to the minting of the medal, conforming to the specimen attached.

The prize will be announced every three years starting from 2015 and it follows prizes announced in 2003, 2006, 2009 and 2012.

The call will be announced, according to the attached diagram, no later than 31th December of the relevant prize year and it will be advertised on UMI website and on the ‘Notiziario’ of the Mathematics Italian Union. Submissions must be sent, accompanied by a curriculum vitae of the applicant, no later than 31th March.

The selection board of each edition of the prize is made up of a panel consisting in 5 members appointed by the Presidency Office of the Mathematics Italian Union and at least 3 of them are selected among winners of previous editions.

The medal will be awarded by the UMI President or his delegate during the opening ceremony of the Three-year International Conference “Variational Analysis and Applications” which will be held the same year in Erice (Sicily) at the “Ettore Majorana Foundation and Centre for Scientific Culture”.
