

The SIF and its EDITORIAL ACTIVITY


SIF was founded in 1897 around the journal "Il Nuovo Cimento" which from January of that year became the "Organ of the Italian Physical Society"



Five year impact factor

- monthly journal of long review articles.
- It deals with topics of particular scientific interest and with up-todate issues pertaining to different fields of physics.
- These reviews, which illustrate the state of the art of specific topics of relevant importance in modern physics, usually are invited papers, which are peerreviewed before publication.



Alerts (with abstract) sent out by Springer and SIF

La Rivista del Nuovo Cimento is available free to read to the members of SIF.

It is also available in the libraries paying subscriptions according to the library rules.

From 2020 the subscription to libraries (usually in packages with with other journals) are dealt by Springer.

There is also a time window for *free to read/download* usually lasting about a month.





Il Nuovo Cimento

Il Nuovo Cimento C is an international bimonthly magazine that publishes contributions selected from conferences and seminars or collected on current topics, in all fields of physics.

All articles are reviewed by one or more experts in the specific sector.

Il Nuovo Cimento C is associated with the European Physical Journal.

The articles published in Il Nuovo Cimento C are listed in ADS, INSPEC, INSPIRE and Scopus.

From 2015 the articles are published online in Open Access




EPJ is a merger and continuation of Acta Physica Hungarica, Anales de Fisica, Czechoslovak Journal of Physics, Fizika A, II Nuovo Cimento, Journal de Physique, Portugaliae Physica and Zeitschrift für Physik.

25 European Physical Societies are represented in EPJ (via SAC)

EPJ gives authors the opportunity to publish in:

- Open Access in 'hybrid' journals (APC for Gold OA) Papers are in green OA with embargo of 12 months.
- and in a new suite of fully Open Access journals.
- EPL Europhysics Letters maintain a cooperation in the form of an editorial transfer agreement

The publishers of EPJ are EDP Sciences, Società Italiana di Fisica and Springer.

Generally 1-2 issues per year come out and are distributed to subscribers to the Physics Journal at no additional cost.

Proceedings of the International School of Physics "E. Fermi"



- SIF in partnership with IOS Press, Amsterdam, publishes the proceedings of the International School of Physics "Enrico Fermi", Varenna
- The School was founded in 1953 and consist of 3-4 courses held every summer
- These proceedings have been published since the foundation of the school, so this book series has immediate pedagogic value and a relevant interest as historic archive.

The electronic version of the Proceedings for Courses from 1995 is offered in open access to the SIF Members via the Members Area.



From the SIF statement on open access (2019)

- Italian Physical Society (SIF) supports the fundamental intention of Plan S ...
- The SIF, as a non-profit association with the aim to promote, favours and protects
 the progress of Physics in Italy and worldwideand thus supports all activities
 that serve this purpose, in particular Open Access.
- However, the SIF is convinced that these activities must serve the advancement of science, must not restrict or disadvantage authors and must be based on resilient and sustainable business models.
- Therefore, the SIF shares the position that "the legitimate aim of making scientific results freely accessible to all must not be thwarted to unintended, science-damaging consequences".

A possible way of implementation of Plan S, not to jeopardise the scientific publishing system, would indeed be to set up international task forces, made of researchers and publishers, to launch pilot projects in various research areas, from science to humanities. A possible model is certainly SCOAP3 at CERN for which a careful analysis of advantages, drawbacks, limits and perspectives should be carefully made.



Conclusion

- For Il Nuovo Cimento entirely produced by SIF the full OPEN ACCESS system is already in place since 2015
- For La Rivista Nuovo Cimento we have a free to read (in a time window) and follow the policy of Springer
- The electronic version of the Proceedings relative to the Courses held starting from 1995 is offered in open access to the individual SIF Members.
- Giornale di Fisica and Quaderni di Storia della Fisica are open to the SIF members
- SIF in Steeering Committees of EPJ and EPL and we are in line with their policy for open access
- Support to Open Access keeping in mind that OA must not restrict or disadvantage authors and must be based on resilient and sustainable business models.
