

Mario Baldassarri Prize 2025

Call for Applications

The Unione Matematica Italiana (UMI), with the support of the Baldassarri family, announces the competition for the

“Mario Baldassarri” Prize 2025

Amount: €3,000

The prize is intended for a mathematician who has not reached their 31st birthday by 31 December 2025, in recognition of outstanding contributions in

algebra, geometry, or number theory,

contained in a single article published in a scientific journal during 2022 or later.

The age limit shall be extended by one year:

- for each child for whom the candidate has taken parental leave of at least one month;
- for each period of leave of at least six months taken for health reasons.

The Selection Committee, in addition to the applications received, may also take into consideration nominations submitted by university bodies, research institutions, scientific academies, or members of the Unione Matematica Italiana. Such nominations must clearly specify the article to be considered for the award.

In the case of multiple nominations referring to different articles by the same candidate, the Committee shall decide which one to take into consideration. Committee decisions shall be taken by majority vote and are final with respect to scientific merit. The Committee may conduct its work electronically.

Should no applications or nominations of adequate scientific quality be received, the Committee may decide not to award the prize.

The Committee shall prepare a final report on its activities, which will be published on the UMI website and in the UMI Newsletter. The report shall include the official motivation for the award and may also contain a reasoned mention of up to two candidates who, though not prize winners, are considered particularly deserving.

Submission of Applications and Nominations

Applications and nominations must be submitted by email to:

and must include, in PDF format:

- the title and bibliographic reference of the candidate's article to be considered for the award, a PDF copy of the article itself, and an abstract (not exceeding five pages) highlighting its significance within the context of the relevant research area and current literature;
- the curriculum vitae of the candidate;
- a copy of a valid identity document;
- any documentation proving the eligibility requirements referred to in Article 1 of the Regulations.

The deadline for submitting applications and nominations is 31 December 2025.

The prize will be presented during the Annual Assembly of the Unione Matematica Italiana, to be held in Bologna in May 2026.
